This National Multiple-Use Approval is subject to the following conditions:

- 1. This National Multiple-Use Approval may only be used in its entirety, and does not apply to any one part of the plans and specifications.
- 2. If there are any changes to the approved plans and specifications this National Multiple-Use Approval does not apply.
- 3. Minor variations to the design as defined in the Building (Minor Variations) Regulations 2009 are permitted; and must be assessed at the building consent stage.
- 4. Mirror images and flipped or handed images of the floor plan and roof plan are permitted.
- 5. The building must not be located within 1m of a relevant boundary.
- 6. This National Multiple-Use Approval can only be used where the following conditions apply:
 - a. Wind zone: Up to and including Extra High as defined in NZS 3604:2011.
 - b. Seismic zone: Up to and including zone 3 and in all subsoil classes as defined in NZS 3604:2011.
 - c. Exposure zone: Limited to sites up to and including Zone D as defined in NZS 3604: 2011. Excludes all microclimatic conditions.
 - e. Climate zone: Limited to sites up to and including Zone 3 as defined in NZS 4218:2009*
 - f. Snow Loading: Limited to a maximum 2.5kPa ground snow load.as defined in NZS 3604: 2011.
 - g. Ground bearing capacity: To be confimed on site by a recognised expert and incorporated into the foundation design at the building consent stage.

Exclusions

- Clause H1 'Energy efficiency' (Objective H1.1 applies only when the energy is sourced from a *network utility operator* or a depletable energy resource).
- * Note that the Fifth Edition Amendment 1 of the Acceptable Solution H1/AS1 and Verification Method H1/VM1 no longer cite this standard.
